*These instructions will teach you how to **burn CDs** using **Finder** on Apple Macintosh Computers*

Overview

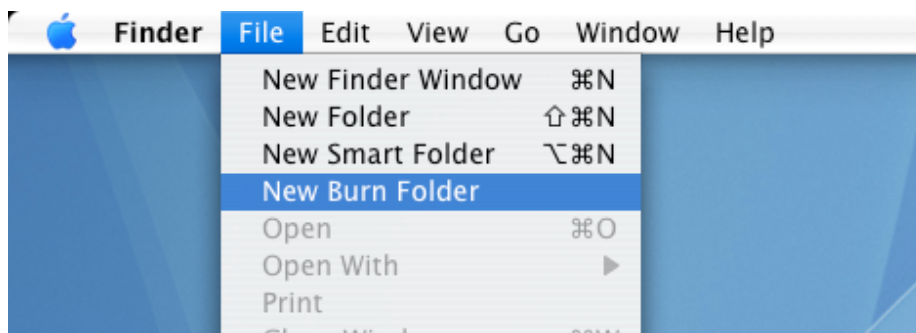
Burning CDs with the Macs is a simple process that consists of 3 steps. First create a new *burn folder*, then place your files in it, and finally burn it when you are ready. These steps are explained in detail below.

Please note that the following steps will help you burn a *Hybrid CD*, which allows you to access the data on your burned disc on both Windows and Macintosh operating systems. Plus, you can use this process for both CD-R, and CD-RW Medias.

(This feature is now embedded into the Finder in Mac OS X 10.4.4 - Tiger.)

STEP 1 - Create a New Burn Folder

From the Finder menu, choose File > New Burn Folder:



A burn folder will then appear on your desktop:

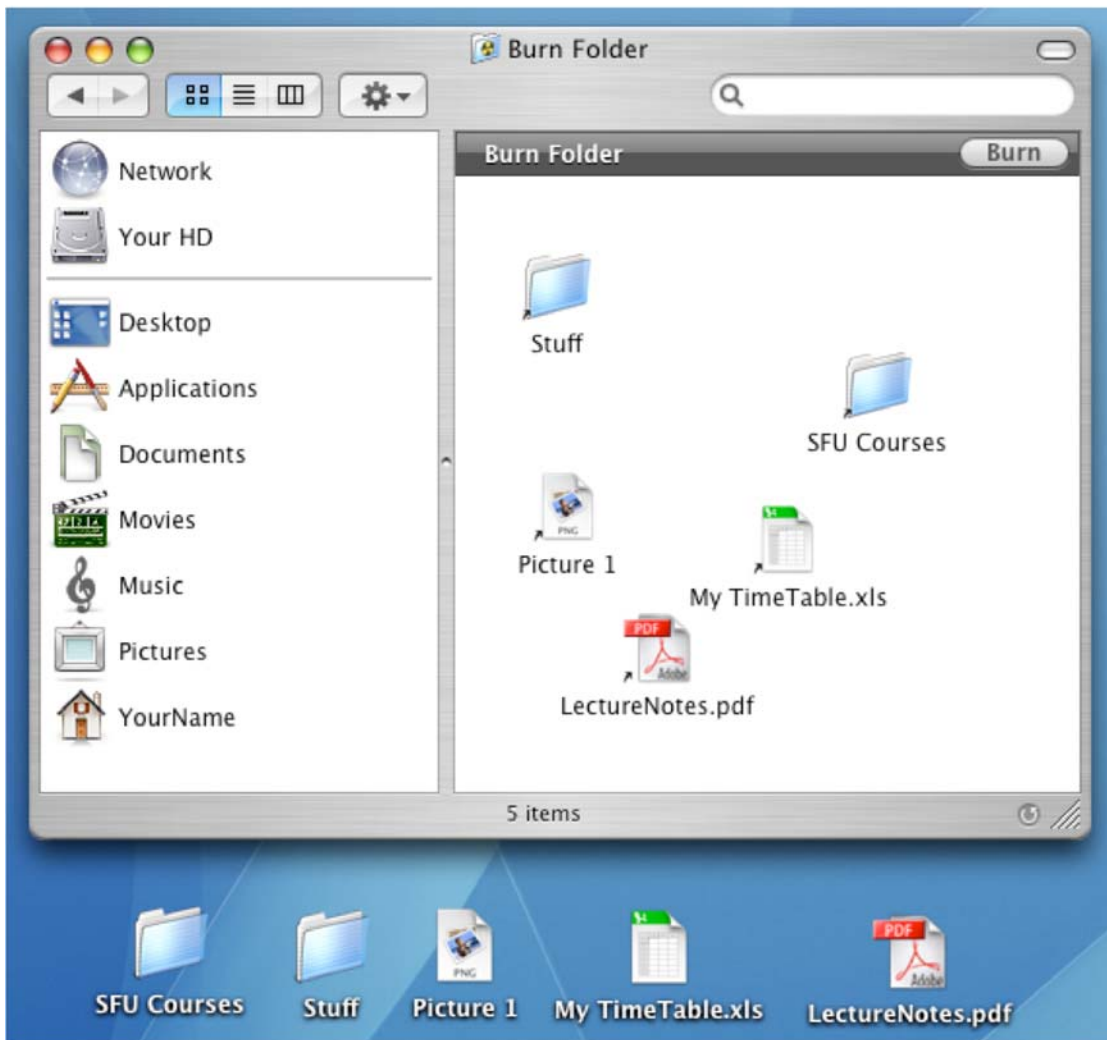

STEP 2 – Place Your Files in the burn folder

Double click on the Burn Folder. Then drag and drop the files you wish to burn onto your disc into the Burn Folder.



You do not have to burn immediately. Before you burn make sure you organize the files and folders the way you want, because after burning you cannot change the way they are set up. In Addition, note that only a reference to the file is copied to the folder, and the actual files are still at their original location. Click on the **“Burn”** button when you are ready.

STEP 3 - Burn the burn folder

If you have not inserted your CD yet, insert your blank CD into the CD drive now.

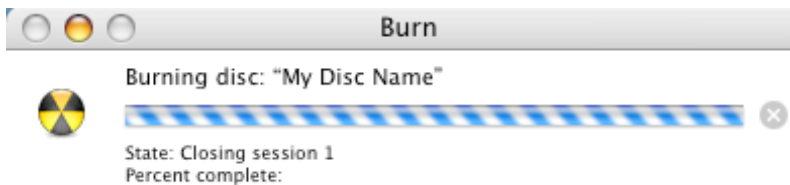


To open the CD drive hold down the Eject button on the top-right corner of the keyboard until it opens.

If you are ready to burn your disc, type in the name you would like your disk to have in the specified field, and click "**Burn**".



Wait until the burn process is finished:



Once the processing is done, you are finished and you can eject the CD.
